

1. Can a teacher initiate an initial evaluation of a child? A-G-4*
 - a. No.
 - b. MTSS team refers
 - c. Parent

2. How much time does the agency have to complete evaluations? B-G-8*
 - a. For an IEP: 60 days with an additional 30 days to write IEP

3. Does a doctor's diagnosis of a condition such as ADD or ADHD confer special education eligibility on a child? C-G-7*
 - a. IEP team must only consider the results from the private evaluation

4. The parents have insurance coverage that could cover the cost of some of the services or therapies included in the IEP. Can we insist that they obtain payment from their insurance company for IEP services? D-G-3*
 - a. No. School must provide FAPE (Free Appropriate Public Education)

5. What happens if a parent brings up a private psychological evaluation during the RtI/MTSS process? A-G-4*
 - a. If an IEP evaluation is conducted - the team must consider the private evaluation results.

6. What if the parents object to only one service provided by the IEP but agree with the remainder? J-G-9*
 - a. An IEP is not ala carte - parents cannot dictate/choose
