## Preparing for Outreach

- Make an appointment
- Research the member
  - Professional: committee assignments, position on issues <a href="https://leg.colorado.gov/legislators">https://leg.colorado.gov/legislators</a>
  - Personal: Occupation? Do they have kids? Where do they send them to school?
- Be on time (and be prepared for them not to be and/or to have to leave early)
- Bring any leave-behind collateral

## Purpose of Outreach

## Establish a relationship

- Importance of your work/the school to their district or to the state
- How you/your school can be a resource on education/charter issues

## Make an ask

- What you want (as well as must-haves vs. negotiables)
- Why you need it/impact on district/state
- Who supports its

# **During Outreach**

- Sample Outline
  - Self introduction
  - Overview of organization & accomplishments
  - Present issue/challenge
  - Ask/Answer Questions
- Ask Questions
  - Ask what matters to them and listen
  - Ask about their position
  - Ask about any obstacles or barriers in the way to what you want
  - Ask if there is someone else you should talk to

# End of/Post Outreach Considerations

- Thank them for the time.
- Offer to provide additional information, invite them for a tour of the program or do an event.
- Thank you note within a week to the legislator AND the staffer.
- Proactively send info relating to their interests (articles, studies, etc.)
