Transfer VS New Enrollment

- Students with an IEP who enroll in your school prior to the start of the school year (over the summer) are not "transfer" students.
- Students with an IEP who enroll in your school during the school year (once school has started) are transfer students.

Summer Enrollment

- Special Education students who enroll in your school over the summer must have a current IEP in place the first day of school.
- The student's IEP from their previous school must be adopted or you must develop a new IEP prior to the first day of school.

Summer Enrollment with Acceptable IEP

- The current IEP from the previous school is adopted, scanned, and uploaded in to the IEP platform used by the charter school.
- All appropriate staff must be notified of the student's IEP.
- State reporting is completed in the IEP platform.

Summer Enrollment Unacceptable IEP

- If the school team determines the student's current IEP is inappropriate:
 - Obtain permission to assess to determine appropriate FAPE;
 - Assess;
 - Within 30 days convene an IEP evaluation meeting with all required members and all appropriate paperwork, including notice of meeting.
 - Develop a new IEP based upon the student's needs.

During the Assessment Process

- The student must be served according to the previous IEP;
- Comparable services may be provided, if required;
- Parents must be provided with Prior Written Notice indicating the comparable services.

Remember: The student must be served based upon their needs, not the school's needs.

Transfer Student

- IEP student who enrolls in the school from another school at anytime during the school year.
- The IEP must be in effect the first day the student enters.
- Any changes need to occur through an official IEP meeting or an IEP amendment.

Types of Transfers

- In-state transfer When a student with an IEP enrolls in your school from another district/school in the state of Colorado.
- Out-of-state transfer When a student with an IEP enrolls in your school from a district/school in a state other than Colorado.

In-State Transfer Students

- Conduct a transfer meeting when a student with an IEP enrolls in your school after the beginning of the school year.
- The school must immediately initiate education services and provide FAPE through special education and related services comparable to the current IEP.
- The team may adopt the current IEP, in which case an IEP meeting may not be required; or they may decide not to adopt and proceed to develop a new IEP through the IEP process.
 - If significant changes are to be made to the current IEP, the evaluation process must be followed.

Out of State Transfers

- If the student with an IEP enrolls, the IEP team must determine if the student meets Colorado eligibility requirements as a student with a disability under ECEA rules.
- If the student would not meet the Colorado eligibility requirements, the IEP team must conduct a new evaluation to determine eligibility following the appropriate steps for an initial evaluation.
- If the student's eligibility determination meets
 Colorado's eligibility requirements, the school may
 adopt the current IEP or determine appropriate
 comparable services until a new IEP is developed.
