It's a cost-effective way to embed the core principles and philosophy into your school culture.



Building on the skills learned on day one, day two focuses on safe physical intervention principles. These techniques are taught to be used as a last resort, when a student becomes an immediate danger to self or others.



With an emphasis on early intervention, day one lays the foundation with nonphysical methods for preventing or managing disruptive behavior. Participants also learn and practice CPI's *Personal Safety Techniques*<sup>SM</sup> to safely remove themselves and others from a dangerous situation.

**BEYOND THE BASICS.** We also have training resources for school bus drivers, parents, and guardians. Additionally, anyone who becomes certified can add depth to their training experience by enhancing skills that support specific content. Our **advanced offerings** include courses that focus on:
