

# Determining Free and Reduced Lunch Eligibility

## School Food Authority (SFA)



CSI school enters into agreement with SFA (either CSI SFA or another district SFA)



School provides electronic list of enrolled students to SFA



SFA runs checks and provides FRL eligibility status back to school



School enters FRL status into SIS for each student record and notifies families when applicable (depending on the SFA, this step can be automatic or

**New in 20-21:** formation of the new CSI SFA



CSI office notifies CSI school to mark homeless, migrant, and foster as free lunch eligible (some SFA's may have the ability to include this data to schools)



School provides **Student Demographic** file with FRL eligibility for October Count and EOY state collections

## Colorado Family Economic Data Survey (FEDS)



CSI school directs families to fill out FEDS forms

**New in 20-21:** CSI schools will be provided access to the TITAN School Solutions to have families complete FEDS forms online



Parents complete FEDS forms online or by paper (for the latter, schools need to fill in data in TITAN)



TITAN runs checks and provides eligibility status back to school



School enters FRL status into SIS for each student record (this process should be automatic with TITAN). Notification to families not required.
