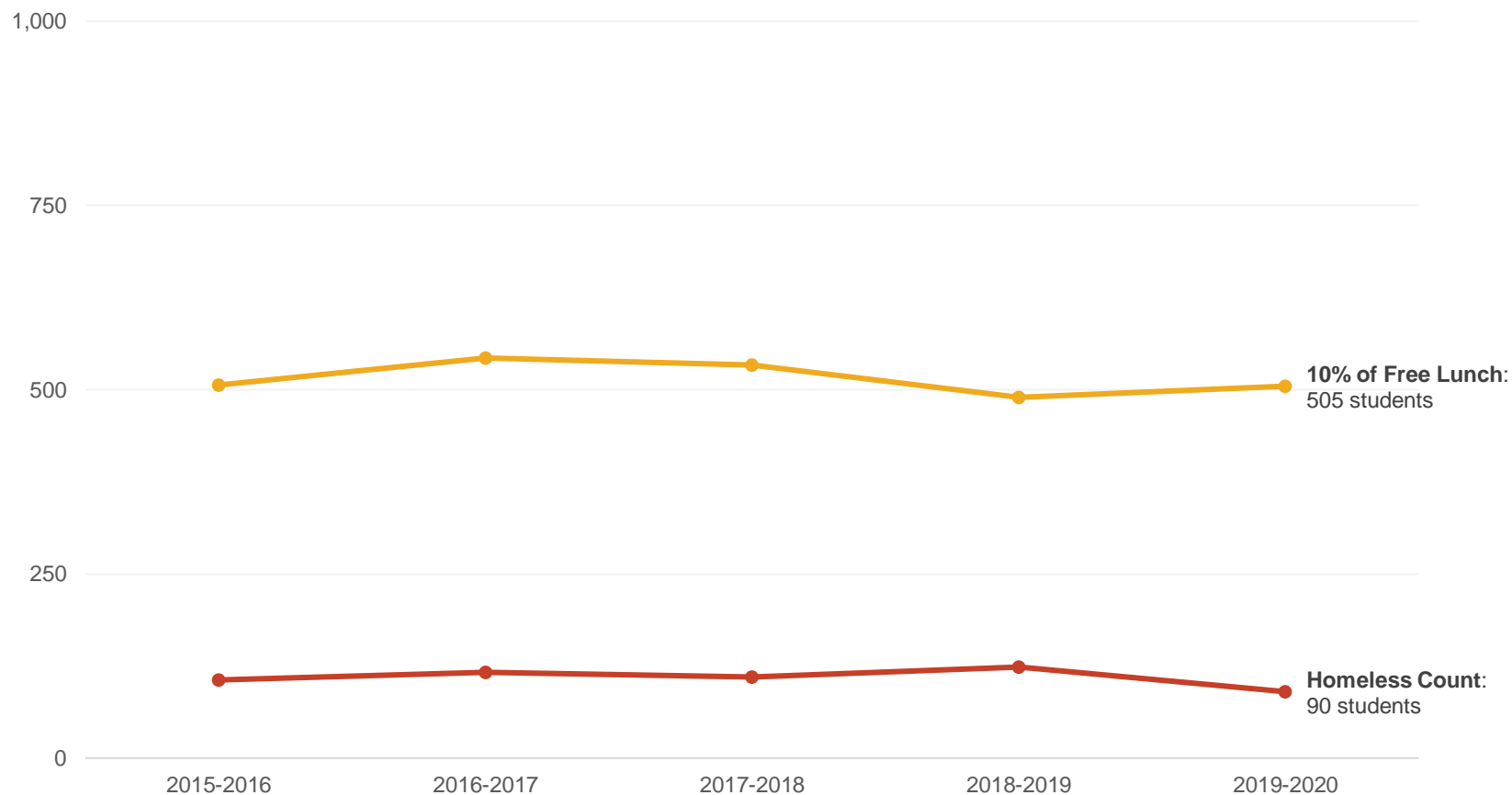

Under Reported

Based on OC data years





Who qualifies under MKV?

Any student who lacks a **fixed**, **regular**, and **adequate** nighttime residence.

Fixed: a residence that is stationary, permanent, and not subject to change.

Regular: a residence that is used on a nightly basis.

Adequate: a residence that is sufficient for meeting both the physical and psychological needs typically met in home environments.



Living situations that qualify

- Sharing the housing of others due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or similar reason – a.k.a. ‘double-up housing’
- Living in motels, hotels, trailer parks, camping grounds due to lack of adequate alternative accommodations
- Living in emergency or transitional shelters
- Abandoned in hospitals
- Living in a public or private place not designed for humans to live
- Living in cars, parks, abandoned buildings, bus or train stations, etc.
- Youth on their own who lack a fixed, adequate and regular primary nighttime residence (unaccompanied youth)



Living situations that qualify

75% Sharing the housing of others due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or similar reason – a.k.a. ‘double-up housing’



COVID & wildfire displacement

- Youth on their own who lack a fixed, adequate and regular primary nighttime residence (unaccompanied youth)

‘Crashing’ with friends; living with signification other.

Coding MKV students basics

Do not code a student as homeless in your SIS ***until you receive confirmation from CSI.***

Homeless status remains the same throughout the school year, regardless of change in housing.

Homeless status may rollover from previous school year. Be sure to check your SIS and audit for homeless flags.



Coding MKV students

1.) Homeless Flag

0 – no; 3 Yes - in custody of parent or guardian; 4 - Yes, not in custody of guardian (is unaccompanied youth)
