Expectations for Student Level Plans

- **Schools** are responsible for maintaining and retaining student level plans
- **CSI** offers schools flexibility in how student-level plans are maintained. As the AU, CSI must have direct and immediate access to records.

Expectations for Special Education State Reporting

- **Schools** are responsible for maintaining a system that aligns with special education state reporting
- **CSI** requires that schools use a system aligned to SPED state reporting

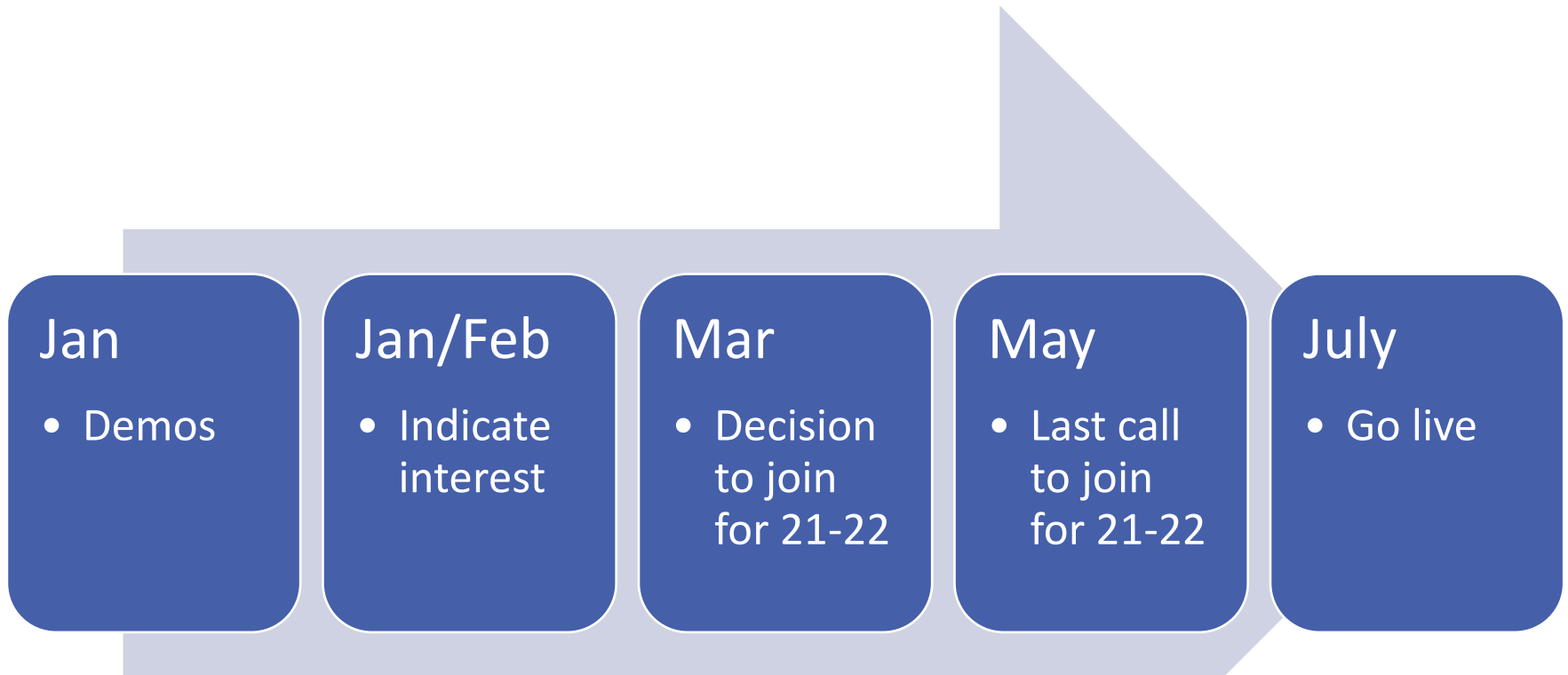


Ascend FAQs

- Data migration – taking place from SPED EOY files, handled by vendor/CDE
- Professional development – Spring/Fall training and training resources, free
- Cost – IEP module is free
- Consistency – state contract ensures 10 years of consistency (CDE will “own the system”)
- CSI schools’ unique needs
 - (+) AnLar will not require data to funnel through CSI before getting into the system
 - (+) AnLar open to working with SIS to automate data syncs
