

## **Military Connected Student Form**

This is a sample form that schools may use as part of their registration paperwork to properly identify and code students with parents or guardians in the military. The purpose of collecting this data is to help to remove barriers to educational success imposed on children of military families because of frequent moves and deployment of their parents.

Students only need to be identified once per school year and do not need to have their status reset during the school year if the military connected parent/guardian's military status changes.
